



## **SCHOOL FREE DRESS GUIDELINES 2007-2008**

The school will have Free Dress Days for students periodically as a reward system. Students will be given Free Dress bracelets for certain days. Student must wear their bracelets for the designated day only. Students must wear appropriate attire for the school setting. Specific dress guidelines are listed below:

- Students may wear denim jeans/shorts/skirts/skorts/capris
- Students may wear jerseys
- Students must wear their student ID badges
- Skirts must follow the school's "fingertip" length requirement
- No high slits in skirts or dresses
- No spaghetti straps or strapless shirts/tops
- No shirts with writing or images associated with sex, drugs, violence, gangs, etc.
- No sleeveless shirts
- No pajama pants or house slippers
- No backless shoes
- No heels higher than 2 inches
- No hats, scarves, bandanas
- All other dress code policies are enforced
